Derek Marinatos

Head Coach | Seventh Season

Entering his seventh season at the helm of the North Florida Men's Soccer program, Derek Marinatos has quickly transformed the Ospreys into a perennial power in the ASUN Conference.

NORTH FLORIDA HIGHLIGHTS

- The Ospreys have gone undefeated in ASUN Conference play in back-to-back seasons, boasting a 4-0-1 conference record in 2015 and a 5-0-1 conference record in 2016.
- In 2016, Jay Bolt was named the ASUN Defender of the year, while Adrian Nunez was awarded the Freshman of the Year.
- UNF received its first ranking in the top-25 in school history and rose to as high as 21 in 2016.
- The Ospreys burst onto the national scene in 2015 after capturing the school's first ever conference championship and a berth into the program's first ever NCAA Tournament.
- Marinatos received back-to-back ASUN Coach of the Year honors in 2015 and 2016.
- In 2015, UNF compiled its first 10-win season in 15 years.
- Marinatos guided the Ospreys to three-straight ASUN Conference Championship games after just the program had just made one playoff appearance prior to his arrival.
- In 2015, a total of eight players garnered All-Conference honors, four went on to be named to the NSCAA All-Region team and Helge Pietschmann became the program's first ever All-American.
- In 2014, the Ospreys were regionally ranked in all but one week and finished the year ninth in the NSCAA Southeast Region.
- Five players garnered NSCAA Region honors and five listed on the Atlantic Sun All-Conference team, both program records.
- Goalkeeper Kyle Nasta was named the Atlantic Sun Goalkeeper of the Year, the first Osprey to take home an individual league honor since 2004.
- In 2013, UNF produced the program's first winning record in more than a decade and the first in the school's Division I era.
- The 2013 Ospreys set a new bar, finishing with an overall record of 8-7-3 and garnering its first All-Conference selection since 2009.

- Marinatos' squad set the school record with a 1.17 team goals against average and a then Division I mark with five shutouts in 2013.
- Goalkeepers Brad Sienkiewicz and Kyle Nasta quickly rose to the top of the school record books. Sienkiewicz made 138 saves in two seasons, which is the second most in school history, while Nasta set the single season, school record for goals against average (1.10) in 2014.
- In addition to the on the field improvements, Marinatos' influence also carried over into the classroom. Four-straight teams have received the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NCSAA) team award for posting a team GPA of a 3.0 or higher. The team boasted its highest grade point average ever with a 3.15 GPA in the spring of 2013 and over a 3.04 GPA for the entire 2012-13 academic year. In four years a total of 53 players have been placed on the ASUN Academic Honor Roll, including a program-high, 15 in 2013.

Josh Dunn

Associate Head Coach | Eighth Season

Josh Dunn was elevated to associate Head Coach prior to the 2015 season. He first joined the North Florida coaching staff in 2010 and was brought on as a full-time assistant when Derek Marinatos was named the Head Coach in 2011.

Dunn has played a key role in the resurgence of North Florida men's soccer program that has seen 13 players receive all-conference honors, 9 players garner NSCAA All-Region accolades and five players named to the Atlantic Sun All-Freshman Team in just five seasons. In his first season as Associate Head Coach, the Ospreys won the program's first ever Atlantic Sun Conference Championship and appeared in the school's first NCAA Tournament. Marinatos and his staff were awarded the 2015 A-Sun Coaching Staff of the Year after the program's first 10-win season in 15 years.

Dunn came to UNF following a stint as the assistant boys' soccer coach at Providence High School last season helping lead the team to a 19-2-1 overall record.

Prior to Providence, Dunn served as the head boys' soccer coach at Fernandina Beach High School for four seasons (2005-09). He guided the Fighting Pirates to a 69-20-9 (.750) mark during his career while overseeing both the varsity and junior varsity squads. Dunn led FBHS to the FHSAA Class 4A State finals along with a regional and district championship in 2006-07.

Dunn also served as the Director of Coaching for the Team America Soccer Club for three years.

A collegiate soccer player at the University of Virginia (1995-96), Dunn was a member of the Cavaliers 1995 Atlantic Coast Conference championship squad.

A standout prep player for Lake Braddock High School, Dunn garnered NCSAA High School All-American accolades as a senior and helped Lake Braddock to the 1995 Virginia High School State championship. In addition, he was a member of six Virginia Youth Soccer State championship teams.

Dunn played for several professional teams after college including the Hampton Roads Mariners (A-League), the Palm Beach Pumas (PDL) and the Northern Virginia Royals of the USL 2.

A graduate of UNF with a bachelor's degree in sport management, Dunn holds a Level "B" USSF National Coaching License.

Dunn and his wife, Tarun, are the proud parents of three children – Isabella, Noah and Mila.

Andrew Barth

Assistant Coach | Fifth Season

Andrew Barth joined the North Florida men's soccer program in August of 2013. Barth serves as assistant coach and works with the Osprey goalkeepers. In addition, Barth helps to coordinate the Derek Marinatos Soccer Academy (DMSA).

Barth has worked with two of the top goalkeepers in school history in his first four seasons. His hard work helped Kyle Nasta win the 2014 Atlantic Sun Goalkeeper of the Year and NCSAA All-Region honors twice. Prior to Nasta, Barth coached Brad Sienkiewicz who is second all-time saves in North Florida men's soccer history.

Barth came to the Ospreys after a year at USC Upstate serving as an assistant women's soccer coach for goalkeeping during the 2012 season. In his time with the Spartans, he worked directly with goalkeeper Sarah Plantz who ranked among the nation's leaders in saves. She earned All-Atlantic Sun Conference honors and was tabbed the 2012 Atlantic Sun Conference Goalkeeper of the Year. In addition,

Plantz was also named 2013 Preseason A-Sun Keeper of the Year.

Under Barth's tutelage, Plantz was tremendous between the pipes in 2012 for Upstate. She tallied a league-best 122 saves and ranked 15th in the nation in total saves. She logged more than 1,500 minutes in goal for the Spartans and made nine or more saves in five matches with two shutouts on the year. She topped all A-Sun keepers in saves per game en route to earning league Goalie of the Year and First Team All-Conference honors. She became the first Upstate women's soccer player to earn a major individual award and all-conference honors from the A-Sun.

He was an assistant with the 2011 Anderson University women's soccer team that went 9-10-1, helping goalkeeper Kaitlyn Neipp earned First-Team All-South Athletic Conference honors that season, as well as All-SAC Tournament honors. Under Barth's direction, Neipp earned Second Team All-SAC honors in 2012.

Barth served as the Director of Goalkeepers at Clemson Anderson Soccer Alliance (2010-13) and Furman United Soccer Club (2008-13) prior to coming to North Florida. In 2013, he was also named the new Director of Goalkeeping at Westside Soccer Club in Jacksonville.

In addition to soccer, Barth also has a strong background in strength and conditioning as he was also a personal trainer and performance coach at Performance QSA in Greenville, S.C. (2007-13).

Barth finished his collegiate career at Anderson University where he earned All-Conference honors in the Conference Carolinas in 2006 and was named the team's Most Improved Player. He also went on to play two seasons in a Semi-Pro Indoor League and Player Development League (PDL).
